

WELLNESS POLICY

Please join us in keeping the children of Mountain Creek healthy by following our wellness policy. If a child appears ill upon arrival or during class time, for the best interest of all MCBC children, parents will be contacted to pick up their child. Prayerfully, these measures will protect your child from illness. We are grateful for your partnership in this area!

Children should not be dropped off if they have displayed any of the following symptoms within the previous 24 hours:

- **FEVER** (any oral temperature over 100)
- **VOMITING** or **DIARRHEA**
- **RUNNY NOSE** with yellow/green discharge
- **COUGH** which may represent bronchitis or pneumonia or simply post-nasal drip, but one cannot be sure at first
- **SORE THROAT**
- **CROUP**
- Any **UNEXPLAINED RASH**
- Any symptom of **CHILDHOOD DISEASE** such as scarlet fever, measles, mumps, chicken pox, or whooping cough
- Any **SKIN INFECTION** such as impetigo, boils, ringworm
- **EYE INFECTION** (pink-eye or drainage)
- **LICE**, or evidence of lice, lice eggs, or nits within past 2 weeks

when in doubt, sit an extra week out
